Deploys New Video Visitation Solution

St. Lawrence County Sheriff Kevin Wells, Jail Administrator Peggy Harper and IT Manager Rick Johnson have just launched a new video visitation program using the NYS Sheriffs' Association (NYSSA) Public Safety & Justice Portal video cloud network (hosted by CDW-G and using Cisco video endpoints).

The Problem: St. Lawrence County's existing system was showing its age and in need of replacement. Fortunately, the NYSSA provided them the opportunity to review and test a new hosted cloud video solution that is now offered to all public safety and justice organizations in New York state.

The Solution: The County invested in four Cisco DX-70 13" video endpoints with hardened cases and placed one each in four separate visitation pods. The devices are set to auto-answer so when it's time for a scheduled video meeting the inmate sits in front of the unit in the visitation room and the calling department initiates the call.

The Results: The County has found the system to be a budget-friendly investment – one that is easy to use and that delivers excellent video quality. Plus, the operating cost of the video network is less than a normal cell phone plan per device once the equipment is purchased.
