CDW Canada survey finds virtualization offers positive ROI for small and medium businesses

The survey, conducted at the company's annual Business Technology Expo (BTEX), shows 59 per cent of virtualization users are seeing the ROI they expected, with another 26 per cent indicating virtualization has yielded better than expected results.
